



Invitation of Tenders Berlin Curling Cup 2015

The Eissport & Schlittschuh-Club 2007 Berlin e.V. hereby invites interested curling clubs to the premiere of the Berlin Curling Cup.

Date and venue:

16 to 18 January 2015; Eishalle (indoor ice rink) PO9, Glockenturmstraße 14, 14053 Berlin.

Rules of the Game:

Participation is open to a maximum of 18 teams. There will be a minimum of 4 games of 6 Ends each.

The first two games are played in the drawn groups, followed by two rounds based on the overall ranking. The six best teams then compete in the open finals.

The rating is based on points / ends / stones.

Timing:

The first games begin on January 16, 2015, at 17:00. The finals will finish on January 18, 2015 around 15:00.

Entry fee:

The entry fee is € 180 per team (4 players) and includes a sports banquet on Friday evening in the indoor ice hall and a buffet on Saturday night as part of a curler evening. Additional tickets for the curler evening can be purchased.

The entry fee must be paid in cash before the first game.

Accommodation:

On January 16, 2015, the so-called "International Green Week", a great fair with thousands of exhibitors and visitors, will start. Therefore, hotel vacancies are expected to be scarce during this time in Berlin, and especially in the City-West. To avoid difficulties in booking hotel rooms, we have tentatively already reserved a certain number of rooms at special rates. We have selected hotels that allow reaching the ice rink in 20 minutes by car and a maximum of 30 minutes by S-Bahn (city train). All necessary information can be found in the attached Appendix.

The curler evening on Saturday will be held in the City East ("Mid-town" / Unter den Linden"). It takes about 30 minutes by car and 40 minutes by S-Bahn to get there from the ice rink.
