



Invitation of Tenders Berlin Curling Cup 2016

The Eissport & Schlittschuh-Club 2007 Berlin e.V. hereby invites interested curling clubs to the Berlin Curling Cup 2016.

Date and venue:

15 to 17 January 2016; Eishalle (indoor ice rink) PO9, Glockenturmstraße 14, 14053 Berlin.

Rules of the Game:

Participation is open to a maximum of 18 teams. There will be a minimum of 4 games. The first two games are played in the drawn groups, followed by two rounds based on the overall ranking. The six best teams then compete in the open finals. The rating is based on points / ends / stones.

Timing:

The first games begin on January 15, 2016, at 17:00. The finals will finish on January 17, 2016 around 15:00.

Entry fee:

The entry fee is \in 220 per team (4 players) and includes a sports banquet on Friday evening in the indoor ice hall and a buffet on Saturday night as part of a curler evening. Additional tickets for the curler evening can be purchased.

The entry fee must be paid in cash before the first game.

Accommodation:

On January 15, 2016, the so-called "International Green Week", a great fair with thousands of exhibitors and visitors, will start in Berlin. Therefore, hotel vacancies are expected to be scarce in this period in Berlin, and especially in the City-West. Early booking is therefore highly recommended!

We have therefore tentatively already reserved a certain number of rooms at special rates in the hotel where most of the participants stayed last time. All necessary information can be found in the attached Appendix.

The curler evening on Saturday probably will be held in the City East ("Mid-town" / Unter den Linden"). It takes about 30 minutes by car and 40 minutes by S-Bahn to get there from the ice rink.
