European Junior Curling Tour - Oslo 2011

12 Girls teams And 12 Boys teams



Girls and boys teams will play in separate tournaments as follows:

The Tournament is played according to the World Curling Federation rules and applying the four rule. All matches are played over 8 ends with an extra end if necessary. If no points are scored extra end the team without the hammer is the winner.

The teams will play a round robin in 2 groups of 6 teams, and a draw shot challenge will be played following the second win for the team. The teams will be ranked by number of wins, and the three highest ranked teams in each group are qualified for the play off. If unable to separate the teams by this, a minimum of tie-breakers will be played. Internal results will be used to rank the teams for the tie-breakers. If necessary, the results from the draw shot challenge will apply.

- Tie-breakers will only be used in case of elimination from the tournament.
- Two tie-breakers will only be applied in case of 3 og 4 teams for one spot or 5 teams for one or 2 spots. All other situations will be solved based on the ranking and a maximum of one tie-breaker.
- 6 end tie-break games will be played. In case of two tie-breakers 4 end games will be played.

The second ranked team from one group plays the third ranked team from the other group in 2 quarterfinals, and the winners play the first ranked team from the group including the third ranked team in the semifinals.

The loosing teams in the quarterfinals are ranked joint 5th.

The loosing teams in the semifinals will play a match for third position.

Prize money will be awarded to the 4 teams reaching the play off, with a total purse of NOK 25.000,- for each group as follows:

1st	10.000,-	10 points
2nd	7.500,-	8 points
3rd	5.000,-	6 points
4th	2.500,-	5 points
5th		4 points
6th		3 points

To win the EJCT a team have to play at least two of the tournaments that season, and the team with most points is the winner of the tour. If unable to separate two or more teams on aggregate points the team with the best single result will be declared winner. If still equal, the best draw challenge result recorded from one of these tournaments will be used to separate the teams. The winners will be invited to play all WCT-E events next season.

The entry fee is NOK 2.000,- pr. team, and will include all meals and the banquet Saturday evening.
